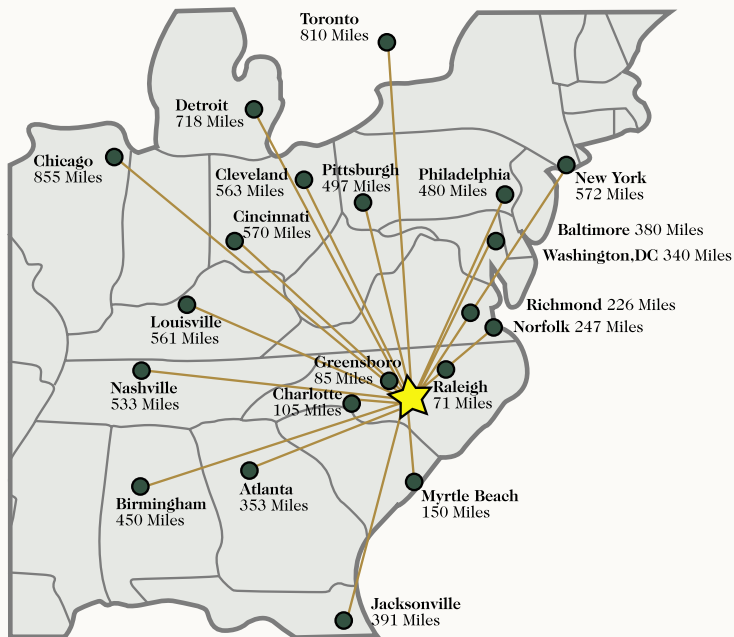

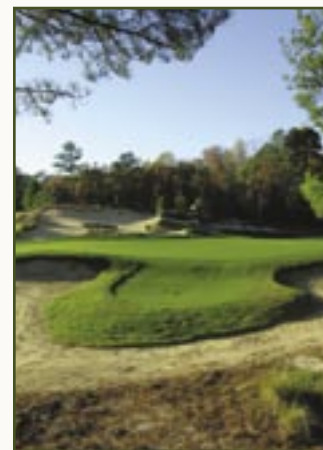

What will my package include?

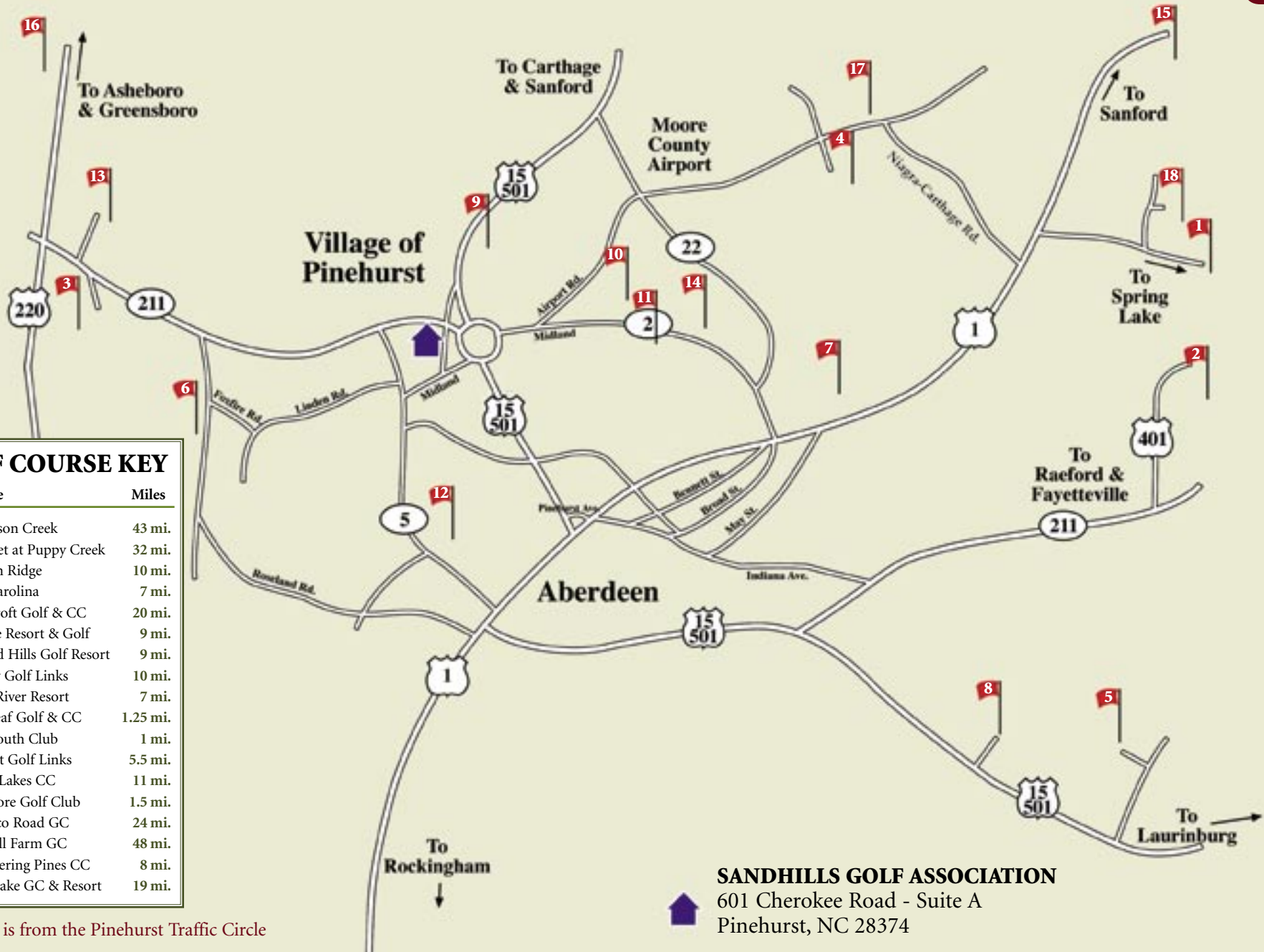
Can I make my deposit or final payment online?

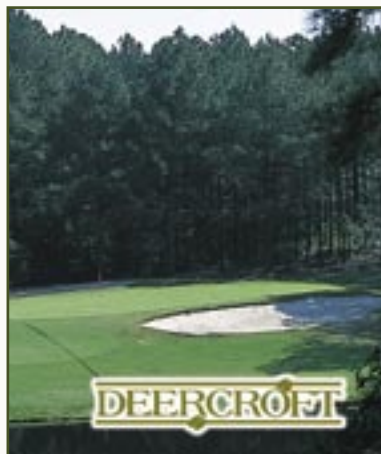

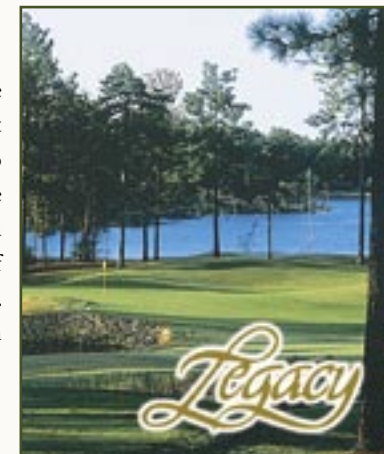

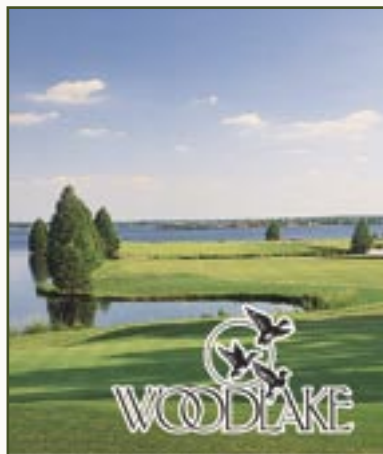
